REGISTRATION CONDITIONS

It is important to read and understand the following conditions below.

CANCELLATION OF A TRIP BY PARTICIPANT:

- \$500 deposit due with registration form is non-refundable.
- Airfare and visa fees due by April 1st are both non-refundable at any time.
- Registrations cancelled after April 1st but before May 1st will be refunded 75% of the trip cost less the \$500 non-refundable deposit (\$1125/1050). Registrations cancelled after May 1st will be refunded at 50% of the trip cost less the \$500 non-refundable deposit (\$750/700).
- Registrations cancelled due to denial by the Ghana Consulate of a visa for entry into Ghana are fully refundable except for any Visa fees or airfare fees. In this case even the \$500 non-refundable deposit WILL be refunded.

LATE REGISTRATION: All registrations made after April 1st will be assessed a \$50.00 late registration fee. No registrations can be accepted after May 1st.

INSURANCE: Travel insurance is compulsory for all Molemo Ghana Tours, LLC participants. Your travel insurance must provide coverage on personal accident, medical expenses, emergency repatriation and liability. We also recommend that your insurance covers cancellation, curtailment, loss of luggage and personal effects. We require that you submit evidence of travel insurance with the final payment due by May st.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

- Ensure that your passport is valid for 6 month beyond the duration of the trip.
- Molemo Ghana Tours, LLC will assist you with obtaining the correct visa. Visa fees, 4 passport photos, original passport and registration forms are due to Molemo Ghana Tours by April 1st. Your passport with a Ghana visa inside will be returned to you promptly upon fulfillment by the Ghana Consulate.
- It is your responsibility to submit copies of your passport with Ghana visa inside, yellow fever vaccination card, and permission to travel form to Molemo Ghana Tours, LLC prior to departure (preferably before May 1st). Molemo Ghana Tours, LLC will carry copies of your travel documents.
- While traveling you must carry a valid passport with your visa inside. You must also carry your yellow fever vaccination card AND the notarized permission to travel form. It is your responsibility to bring your original passport with Ghana visa inside, original yellow fever vaccination card, and original permission to travel form to the airport for departure. We will check your original documents at the airport before check-in.
- Molemo Ghana Tours, LLC will hold your passport with Ghana visa inside, yellow fever vaccination card, and permission to travel form in a lock-box while in Ghana.
- We cannot be responsible for your denial of entry into Ghana due to the lack of correct documentation.
- You must *carry your own travel insurance*. You may decide to carry your own trip insurance.

FOOD AND COOKING: The trip participation fee includes all meals. Participants will be offered a breakfast, lunch and dinner each day. On some days with long trips, lunch foods will be carried in coolers on the bus. A couple of visits to local restaurants are scheduled in the itinerary. With the exception of the scheduled restaurant visits, all foods will be prepared in the traditional manner by the hostess at the compound where we will lodge in Kokrobite. We will take meals as a group of participants, chaperones, and Molemo Ghana Tours, LLC staff, often joined by members of the household and local community. Meals will have fixed menus and occur at set times. Some participant input will be solicited for meal choices from available options. Meals will be prepared from fresh ingredients from scratch in the home kitchen. As such, meals are nourishing and nutritious. Participants should be prepared to try new foods.

We can accommodate a vegetarian diet by preparing a meatless/fishless version of the meal separately. However, due to the nature of the local cuisine, ingredient availability and the style of local cooking, we cannot accommodate any other specialized diets such as Kosher or Vegan.
